



Most our work for the month of December were done in Vietnam, Thailand, and Laos. The works we did in these countries are being shared in the HIM newsletter. For this month's newsletter from Indonesia, we will briefly recap some of the activities that happened through out this past year in a short paragraph and photos.

We are pleased to report that through out the year of 2008 we had 25 volunteers from the United States, Japan, and Indonesia served the Lord with us. We had 18 guests from the US, Hong Kong, Japan and Australia stayed at our Center. We held 10 leadership training sessions for the English teachers in the middle schools. We offered 5 computer training sessions to ten specially selected teachers. Our volunteers made over 2,650 contacts with students, 255 contacts with teachers and 537 contacts with people in the community. We also had 56 guests from the local areas visited our Center. One of our happiest moments was serving Thanksgiving dinner to 55 orphans in Banda Aceh. We held Bible study every night and had our own worship service at the Center twice a month. In addition, we made 3 trips to Thailand, 2 trips to Vietnam, 1 trip to Laos, 4 trips to Medan, 1 trip to Bali, and 3 trips to Jakarta for Gospel touches. We also traveled to Hong Kong, Singapore, and the United States for trainings and other work related events.
